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## ABSTRACT

There has been much research conducted regarding developing strategies to prevent student's dropout of schools. Although research shows that life can become very difficult economically and socially for high school dropouts, some adults decide to return to further their education after many years away from a school setting.

This study was conducted in order to answer the research questions, such as what are the reasons for early school dropout, consequence for early school dropout, strategies to prevent students from dropping out of school, and the control measure both parents and teachers to prevent early school dropout?

The purpose of this qualitative research study was to gain an understanding of the motivations of developing strategies to prevent student's dropout school. The method of conducting this study from a qualitative angle was interviewing individuals and group transcript who are currently enrolled in a developing strategies to prevent student's dropout school.
