

05. Credit cards

Credit cards can be more convenient than cash when you are buying things. Sometimes they are safer and easier to carry than money. Your account can be used as a credit reference when you need to borrow money. Some cards are accepted internationally, which means they can be used in other countries to buy things.

Your signature appears on the back of the credit card. Some companies put your picture on the card to prevent other people from using it: a picture also gives you identification. Most stores keep a list of stolen cards and check it before they allow people to charge things. Some stores check with a computer.

You pay interest each month on the amount of you charge, if you do not pay your total bill. The amount depends on the company with which you have an account.

With most bank credit cards you will not pay any interest if pay your account completely within 25 days. Otherwise, the annual interest or percentage rate is approximately 18% annually or 1.5% per account.

Some bank credit cards can be used in a machine provided by the bank when the bank is not open for business, to get money from your checking or saving account, to make deposits to pay loans, to transfer money from one account or to get cash borrowed on your credit card account.

You can get checks drawn against your bank credit card. The interest you pay starts the day the checks are drawn and stops on the day you repay the money to the credit card company.
